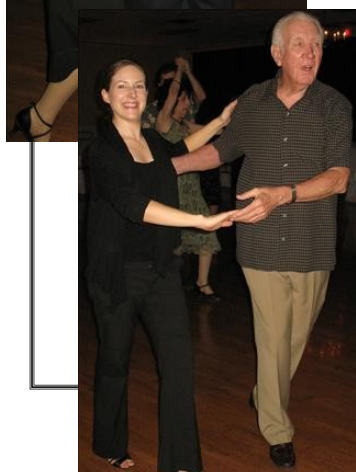

# Competition Update

Before we know it the competition will be here, June 25-27, at the Crowne Plaza Hotel in Baton Rouge. So much has happened over the last month and it will be nearly impossible for me to capture everything to share with all of you. But, let me try to give you an appreciation of the building excitement.

Registrations for the Gumbo DanceSport Championships have far surpassed last year's numbers and on track to be our largest national qualifying event yet. But, the story is actually bigger than just numbers. At every level of competition, we have strong competition, so the dance floor will definitely be the focus of excitement on Friday and Saturday of the weekend. Dancers will join us from 23 states and 12 of those couples are current reigning national champions in their age groups and skill levels. The competition will be fierce, but one thing we are sure of; the new friends made over the weekend will be many.

In the fall of 2009, we kicked off our fundraising campaign and enlisted the support of our entire planning committee. We set a very ambitious goal of \$16,000, with the idea in mind to increase significantly the amount awarded for scholarships. There were doubts and fears as we began the drive, but our team felt very committed to the cause, because we are determined to be the most sought after National Qualifying Event in the country. Today I am proud to announce that we have exceeded the goal. As of June 14<sup>th</sup>, the donations amount to \$19,978.25\* (123% of the goal). Because of the wonderful generosity of companies, organizations and individuals we are assured of nearly doubling the amount awarded in scholarships. Hats are off to everyone who has given unselfishly either financially and/or hard work to make this happen. The excellent scholarship program will likely be one of our greatest selling tools as we continue to host this prestigious weekend of competition. Our fundraising campaign results are listed below.
